

On Sunday we introduced a new series entitled “Knowing God.” The introduction made clear the entire gospel, including Christ’s coming, the Holy Spirit’s arrival, the production of the Bible and the presence of the church, was to restore God’s relationship with His much loved children. We need not fear the future or be anxious about any situation, for our God has made a covenant with us to be a Father and Friend for ever!
